The Center for Family Outreach was established in December of 2000 as a non-profit organization offering **PREVENTION, EDUCATION, EARLY INTERVENTION** services and programming for youth ages 11 to 18. We focus on adolescents struggling with substance abuse, mental health issues, high family conflict and high risk adolescent behavior. The Center **EMPOWERS** youth and their families to believe that good, happy lives are possible once families commit to change and learn how their individual commitments and work can restore hope.

Our educational programming and early intervention strategies encourage families to embrace a new way of parenting in today's changing world. By encouraging healthy limits, establishing boundaries and increasing communication, our goal is to teach skills to help strengthen individuals, families and their relationships.

How does this correlate to Larimer County students?

We know that Larimer County has a growing behavioral health issue and our young people are requiring a higher level of continuum of care. The Center's community - based resource center provides for identification and intervention of multiple services such as case management, individual and family therapists, education programs, addictions counseling and parent support.
